City to launch website. Later this month the City of McLeansboro will launch a newly-designed city website in an effort to enhance online transparency and to create a user-friendly site for our residents, businesses, and visitors.

The website will feature enhanced functionality as well as a clean, simple layout to navigate. In addition, the website will use a responsive design, which will allow for easy viewing no matter the device.

The design allows for quick access to information on city meetings, agendas and minutes, and City Municipal Code Regulations, as well as updated information on elected officials, and departments. It will also allow access to important and popular forms such as zoning permits, demolition permits, commercial dig permits, job applications, utility connections/disconnections, and service requests. City maps featuring political districts, zoning districts, and garbage pickup routes/dates will be available on the website as well.

Republic Garbage Services will run without interruption of services this month. Please put your totes out the evening before pick-up and remove them from street-side as soon as possible following pick-up. **All trash should be bagged and inside the tote. Republic is not required to accept additional bags of trash at curb-side.**

The Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration has issued a new regulation. Please read the letter from Bob Cross, McLeansboro Gas Superintendent, on the back of this newsletter for details. **The newly mandated Excess Flow Valves are not required for existing customers, but you now have the option to pay for an EFV to be installed if you so desire.**

Thank you for keeping our meter readers safe by providing clean and easy access to utility meters.
