## November 2017

**City Hall will be closed Friday, November 10<sup>th</sup> in observance of Veteran's Day, and on Thursday and Friday, November 23<sup>rd</sup> & 24<sup>th</sup> in celebration of Thanksgiving.**

**Republic Garbage Services will not run on Thanksgiving; Thursday service will occur on Friday, November 24<sup>th</sup>.** Please put your totes out the evening before pick-up and remove them from street-side as soon as possible following pick-up. The new truck with an automatic arm is in use—**the tote lid may or may not be left up after collection.** Please ensure that multiple totes are a minimum of three feet apart and at least three feet away from parked cars, light poles, etc. Please ensure that totes are placed with the hinged side away from the street. **All household waste should be bagged and inside the tote. Republic is not required to accept additional bags of trash at curbside.** Totes not in compliance will not be emptied. To rent an additional residential tote contact Lisa @ 618-693-3164. For new commercial service contact Josh @ 618-751-4914.

**Republic Garbage Services observes the following Holidays for residential customers: New Year's Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day and Christmas Day. The collection service is adjusted by one day following those Holidays.**

**City Code requires clear and easy access to all City utility meters. Thank you for keeping our meter readers safe, and making their jobs easier.**

**Leaf burning** is allowed as long as the leaves are not burned on City Streets, or the fires left unattended.

**NOTICE: The City is not responsible for mail delivery. Failure to receive billing does not relinquish responsibility for payment or penalty. Any utility bills not paid by 4:00 P.M. on Friday, November 17<sup>th</sup> will result in the customer having services stopped on Monday, November 20<sup>th</sup>. A reconnect fee of \$25.00 will be charged. Customers are responsible for all costs requiring collection.**
