Following the Pledge of Allegiance, Mayor Chad May called the regular meeting of the McLeansboro City Council to order. Roll call: Tom Maulding, Tom Murk, Sharon Bowman, Jeff Johnson, Mark Brown, Jeff Reyling – present.

Mr. Murk made a MOTION TO APPROVE THE MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF FEBRUARY 20, 2024 second Ms. Bowman. Roll call: Murk, Bowman, Maulding, Johnson, Brown, Reyling. Ayes - 6. Nay - 0. Motion passed.

Item #2 regarding updating the fire department's software was tabled.

During public comments, Mr. Rodney Campbell informed the council of his upcoming Crappie tournament. Mrs. Jamie Brock and Mrs. Janelle Brown spoke regarding the money that was raised for the dog pound. Mr. Bruce Morrison and Mr. Ron Craddock from the Kiwanis Club spoke regarding updating Kiwanis Park including putting new playground equipment and asking the city to go in half with them. Sean Henry and Rod Martin from Klingner & Associates updated the council on projects they are working on for the city, including the sanitary sewer project.

Mr. Murk made a MOTION TO PURCHASE A USED CHEVROLET TAHOE FROM THE MISSOURI STATE POLICE FOR THE CITY'S K9 UNIT, WITH THE UNDERSTANDING THAT A TRUCK ORDERED FROM TEFFERTILLER MOTORS WOULD BE BOUGHT BY ANOTHER PARTY, second Mrs. Bowman. Roll Call: Murk, Bowman, Maulding, Johnson, Brown, Reyling. Ayes -6 . Nay - 0. Motion passed.

Mr. Johnson made a MOTION TO HIRE 3 TEMPORARY PART-TIME SUMMER WORKERS FOR PUBLIC WORKS, second Mr. Brown. Roll Call: Johnson, Brown, Maulding, Murk, Bowman, Reyling. Ayes -6 . Nay - 0. Motion passed.


