Following the Pledge of Allegiance, Mayor Chad May called the regular meeting of the McLeansboro City Council to order. Roll call: Tom Maulding, Sharon Hall, Jeff Johnson, Mark Brown, Jeff Reyling, Duke Griesemer – present.

Mr. Brown made a MOTION TO APPROVE THE MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF JUNE 17, 2025, second Mr. Maulding. Roll call: Brown, Maulding, Hall, Johnson, Reyling, Griesemer. Ayes - 6. Nays - 0. Motion passed.

During public comments, Mayor May reminded all elected officials of the Southeastern Illinois Planning Commission dinner meeting on July 16 at 6:00pm at the Big Red Barn. Mr. Chad Beene spoke to the council regarding obtaining a liquor license for his soon to be opened business located at 112 South Washington Street. There were no further public comments.


Mayor May read, for the second time, Ordinance #25-1127 regarding changes to appointed offices.
